The provided criteria for 'dependent children' or 'other persons' align with the requirement that family size align with who the student and/or parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the student and/or parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2025-26 FAFSA. As a result, the student and/or parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.

DEPENDENT STUDENT should include:

- Student
- Student's parents, even if the student is not living with them. Exclude a parent who has died or is not living in the household because of separation or divorce. Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S. armed Forces apart from the family.
- If parent is re-married, include step-parent
- The student's siblings if the following are true:
- 1. They live with the student's parents (or live apart because of college enrollment)
- 2. They receive more than half of their support from the student's parents, and
- They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student's parents during the award year
- Other persons if the following are true:
- 1. They live with the student's parents,
- 2. They receive more than half of their support from the student's parents, and
- They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student's parents during the award year.

INDEPENDENT STUDENT should include:

- Student
- Student's spouse, if applicable.
- The student's dependent children if the following are true:
 - 1. They live with the student (or live apart because of college enrollment);
 - 2. The receive more than half of their support from the student; and
 - 3. They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student during the award year.
- Other persons if the following are true:
 - 1. They live with the student;
 - They receive more than half of their support from the student; and
 - They will continue to receive more than half their support from the student during the award year.
